

## Hexagon Grid Extension

The Hexagon Grid extension implements an image grid. On hover, each image can display a title and description. This image can be linked to another page or trigger a lightbox.

Hexagon Grid can be used in responsive layouts (with breakpoints) or inside a layout grid for full width/flexible layouts.

### Adding images

Click 'Add' to add a new image. To add multiple images at once, hold down the SHIFT-key on your keyboard while pressing the Add-button.

Each image can have a title, description, link and background color.

**Background Color**

Specifies the default background color of the content area. You can also give each hexagon item a different background color. This color can be set in the properties of the image.

**Opacity**

Specifies the opacity of the background color.

**Text Color**

Specifies the text color.

**Scale**

Specifies the scaling factor of the hexagon items. This can be used to control the spacing between the images. For example, if you use a scaling factor of 0.98, then the images will be smaller so there will be more space between the images. The default value is 1.00

**Columns**

Specifies the number of images in a row. This value is responsive so it can be different in breakpoints. There is also an 'auto' option. In that case, the hexagon grid will use built-in breakpoints.

**Text**

Specifies the styling of the text in the content area.

**Transition**

The slider supports two types of transitions: fade and slide. There are also 10 different types of easing.

**Lightbox**

The gallery also supports lightboxes so when you click an image then a lightbox slideshow will be launched. Most WWB lightbox add-ons are supported:

***How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?***

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\
