

Multi Layout Slideshow

This extension for WYSIWYG Web Builder implements a slideshow where each slide can have a different layout. There are 16 different layouts, for example: grid, circles, cards stack, several magazine layouts etc.

The Multi Layout Slideshow can be used in responsive layouts (with breakpoints) or inside a layout grid for full width/flexible layouts.

Adding slides / images

The number of images per slide depends on the selected layout.

The required number of images is displayed in the 'Images' field.

Some layouts have a fixed image count while for others the count depends on the number of columns / rows. Each slide can have a title, description, and an optional link.

Padding

Specifies the padding around the slides. This makes it possible to display the image with an offset from the edges. For example, if you do not want the next and previous buttons on top of the images.

Interval

Specifies the interval between the slides in seconds. If this value set to 0, then the slides will not rotate automatically.

Filter

This option makes it possible to apply a filter to the thumbnail images. The filter will be removed when the mouse is hovered over the images.

The following filters are available:

- sepia
- grayscale
- blur
- opacity – light
- opacity - dark

Border

Specifies the width, color and radius of the image border.

Text

Specifies the font, color, alignment and padding the titles and descriptions.

Button

Specifies the styling of the 'Read More' button. If you leave the Text field empty, then the button (with link) will not be displayed.

Navigation

Specifies the style, size and offsets of the navigation buttons (next, previous).

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\
